The Fundación Goya en Aragón is offering four research grants in 2009 in two formats, aimed at providing financial support for research projects. The two formats are:

1 ONE TWO-YEAR RESEARCH GRANT (Grant A)
3 THREE RESEARCH GRANTS (Grants B)

The grants are available to teachers, PhD candidates and researchers who apply on an individual basis. The grants are intended to fulfil one of the Fundación Goya en Aragón's key objectives: to promote research into Francisco de Goya and to encourage the study and dissemination of his life and work.

**TWO-YEAR RESEARCH GRANT (GRANT A):
CALL FOR PROPOSALS**

**RESEARCH GRANTS (GRANT B):

CONDITIONS OF AWARD

- 1) The call for proposals for the **Fundación Goya en Aragón Research Grants** places no limits on age, nationality or place of residence.
- 2) The Fundación Goya en Aragón and its Scientific Committee will appoint a Jury, which will examine the applications and award the Grants from amongst the research projects which are submitted to them. No appeal lies from the decision of the Jury.
- 3) One TWO-YEARLY RESEARCH GRANT of 24,000 Euros and three RESEARCH GRANTS of 3,000 Euros each will be awarded.
- 4) The Jury has the power to declare one or more Grants void.
- 5) Each of the successful recipients of a Grant will be informed by post of the Jury's decision before 1st October 2009.
- 6) Once notified, those awarded a Grant must send written acceptance of the award, submitting one letter of acceptance for each category of award.
- 7) The sum awarded under **Grant A** will be paid in three instalments: one instalment (8,000 Euros) in October 2009, a further instalment in May 2010 (8,000 Euros) and a final payment of 8,000 Euros upon submission and approval of the final research report, totalling the sum of 24,000 Euros.
The sum awarded under **Grant B** will be paid in two instalments: one in December 2009 (2,000 Euros) and a final payment of 1,000 Euros in October 2010.
- 8) The final research report drawn up by recipients of **Grant A** shall be submitted within a maximum

period of two years after the Jury's decision is made public. The recipient of the Grant shall send the Fundación Goya en Aragón a summary of the project and how it is to be executed and shall do so no more than 12 months after the Jury's decision has been announced. The summary shall include an outline description of the final project, an explanation of how the research undertaken thus far has resulted in the project in question and the content of that research.

The Fundación Goya en Aragón will assign a co-ordinator to the recipient of **Grant A** to supervise and guide the research project.

The award holder shall undertake to keep in periodic contact with the co-ordinator. All payments apart from the first instalment will be made subject to receipt of the co-ordinator's progress report.

Once the tenure of **Grant A** award holders has expired, the award holder shall submit two copies of the research report in October 2011 to the Fundación Goya en Aragón (both in digital format and a hard copy).

Recipients of **Grant B** shall conclude their research activities no more than one year after the Jury's decision is made public. The Fundación Goya en Aragón will assign a co-ordinator to the recipient of **Grant B** to supervise and guide the research.

Once **Grant B** has expired, the award holder shall submit a summary of the research funded by the award to the Fundación Goya en Aragón in October 2010 (two copies shall be submitted).

- 9) The above documents shall be submitted within the deadlines established in the terms of the award. The Fundación Goya en Aragón otherwise reserves the right to recover the grant monies already paid to the award holder.
- 10) The subject areas for the research projects are Goya's artistic development and that of his tea-

chers and contemporary artists, the historical period through which he lived, the historical documents from his birth to date and his influence on modern taste and aesthetic values in art, literature, film and literary and artistic criticism etc.

- 11) If it so chooses, the Fundación Goya en Aragón shall be entitled to publish the research funded by **Grant A** either in whole or in part, acquiring the intellectual property rights in the work, and shall do so in period of less than five years. Once this period has expired, the author will be entitled to publish the funded research in any way he or she sees fit if the Fundación Goya en Aragón has not already done so, although he or she must make it clear that the work was funded by a grant from the Fundación Goya en Aragón.

The Fundación Goya en Aragón shall be cited as the funding body in all publications containing research funded by **Grant B**, and shall receive at least two copies of the works published. Furthermore, in the event the Fundación Goya en Aragón Scientific Committee wishes to publish the entire research report, because it meets the Foundation's objectives, it shall inform the author that it wishes to publish the work and shall reach an agreement permitting publication.

- 12) Applicants for funding shall submit their proposals and appendices thereto at the offices of the Fundación Goya en Aragón at Paseo Pamplona, 15, entlo. dcha. 50004 Zaragoza (Spain) (open from 9 am to 2 pm) in a sealed envelope, either by hand or by registered mail, before 2 pm on 15 July 2009.

- 13) Applicants must submit the following documents:
- A completed application form (this will be available on the Fundación Goya en Aragón's web site (www.fundaciongoyaenaragon.es) or can be obtained at the Foundation's offices), stating which category of Grant is being sought.

- A photocopy of the applicant's National Identity Document or Passport.
- A curriculum vitae supported by documentary evidence.
- Academic record.
- Letters of recommendation from relevant persons or institutions.
- **Grant A:** A research proposal, providing a description of the applicant's research plans, including: the type of research proposed, the reason for undertaking the research, the objectives, bibliography, the research methods and schedule for completing the various stages. The proposal shall be no more than 15 pages in length.
- **Grant B:** A research proposal, providing a description of the applicant's research plans, including: the subject or title of the research project, a research plan, research methods, resources required, objectives and an explanation of how the funding is to be spent. The proposal shall be no more than 8 pages in length.
- Evidence of the applicant's level of competence in the languages required in order to undertake the research.
- All documents must be typewritten in Spanish or English.
- Documents must be submitted in duplicate.

- 14) Unsuccessful applicants may collect their project documents, either in person or through an appointed representative, up to two months after publication of the Jury's decision. Documents not collected by the end of that period will be destroyed.
- 15) Applications which do not comply with all the above conditions will not be considered.
- 16) The Jury's decision is final and applicants cannot take any action before the courts or any other

body to have the Jury's decision overturned. Applicants shall accept the decision and the Fundación Goya en Aragón will not respond to individual queries concerning the award of the Grants.

- 17) By submitting an application for one of these Grants the applicants accept the above Conditions of Award and any other conditions which the Fundación Goya en Aragón may establish in order to monitor the progress of the research projects.
